Our new **Wayfinders Youth Leadership Council** is comprised of 10-12th grade scholars who are growing their leadership skills and sharing their voices to shape our programming!



We welcomed **Lazetta Lutrillo** to the Wayfinders team as our Family and Academic Success Coordinator! She connects families to valuable resources and skill-building opportunities, providing wrap-around support for our scholars every step of the way.



**LOOKING AHEAD:** Our summer just got even better! We're excited to add new camp partners – **YMCA Camp Harrison**, **NC State University's Engineering Camp**, and **UNC Greensboro's Technovation For Good and CHANCE camps**. Plus, a partnership with A Thousand Summers will send three scholars to **Sanborn Western Camps in Colorado!**

# BY THE NUMBERS

## CAMP EXPERIENCE

- 87%** of scholars can't wait for camp next year!
- 95%** of scholars built friendships at camp with people from different backgrounds, experiences, and places.
- 89%** of Wayfinders parents reported an increased level of responsibility and maturity in their child after camp.

## YEAR-ROUND ENRICHMENT

- 92%** of graduated scholars felt more confident after participating in Wayfinders activities.
- 97%** of scholars enjoyed the enrichment activities they participated in.
- 97%** of parents said our enrichment activities were beneficial for their children.

## ACADEMIC SUCCESS

- 91%** of scholars are confident that they can succeed in the upcoming school year.
- 100%** of scholars graduated middle school and entered 9th grade on time!
- 100%** of scholars graduated high school on time!

## MENTORING

- 88%** of scholars were connected to a new opportunity or resource through their mentor!
- 90%** of scholars felt supported by their mentor.
- 90%** of Wayfinders board members are mentors or parents of scholars.

# MENTOR SPOTLIGHT

Reflecting on her seven years as a Wayfinders mentor, Rossie describes the experience as **“nothing short of an adventure itself!”** At Wayfinders, we view mentorship as a valuable exchange of social capital between the mentor and the scholar. Rossie shared that she initially sought out this volunteer opportunity as a way to **“invest in someone outside of myself,”** but she admits, **“I can honestly say that I have gotten more out of my experience with Wayfinders than I ever imagined I would.”** Her mentee, Jakhia, is someone she describes as “an individual whose light already shines so bright, it’s impossible to ignore,” and adds, “She keeps me young.” Rossie has been an invaluable member of our Board of Directors since 2022.

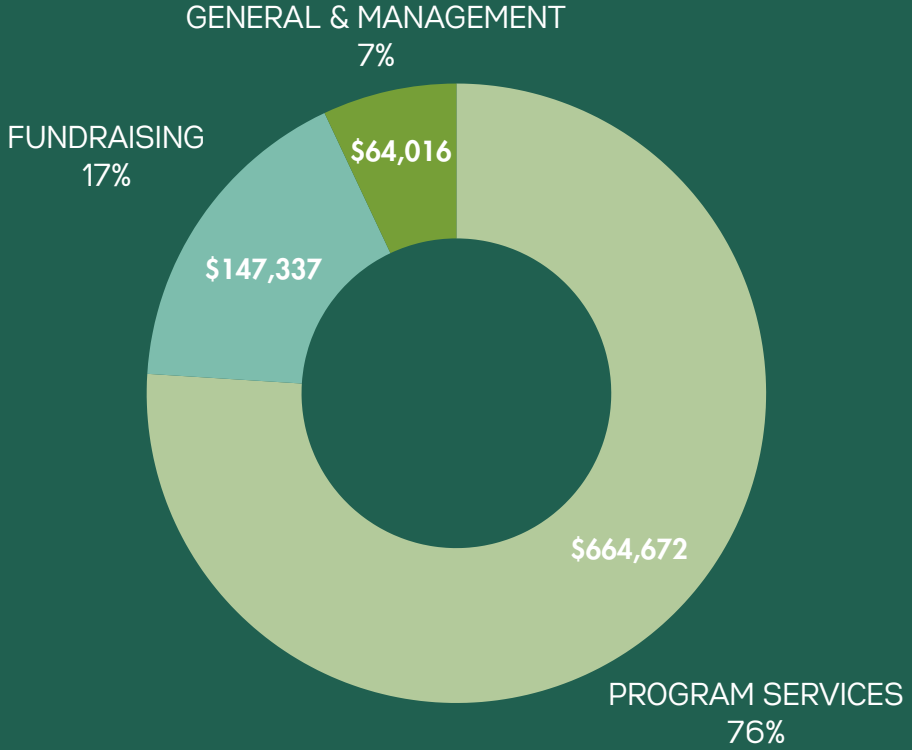
# ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT
